

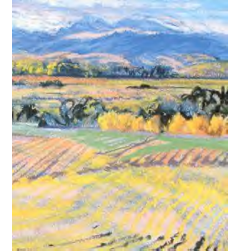

CHARACTER/CHEMISTRY MANAGEMENT --- BOB BENNETT

A discussion was led by Bob Bennett (myself) regarding what we as winemakers do to affect the character of our finished wine. We started with the vineyard and discussed the progression through crush, fermentation and aging. The discussion was followed by judging of our Italian varietals. We had ten nice wines and awarded two Golds and eight Silvers. I hope the 42 there agree it was a productive meeting.

MAY MEETING -- DEVELOPING AND MAINTAINING A SMALL VINEYARD

So you want to develop your own vineyard, do you? Carmine has considerable experience doing just that! Whether it is a small commercial vineyard, or a backyard vineyard, Carmine has the scoop. The quality of the wine starts in the vineyard, so learn about it. Good grapes, good wine! Don't waste time and money on inferior grapes; learn what to look for when ordering. If you already have your vineyard, Carmine will deal with thoughts about how to manage it properly. He will touch on activities you should be doing, including the timing and the costs of managing your vineyard. To close out the meeting, I ask four volunteers to each bring two bottles of wine to share and discuss, but this time I want wine made from your own vineyard.
