Taylor Bianco spent a great deal of his childhood among food, wine, and fine dining in his father's renowned seafood restaurant in South Florida with more than a decade of experience in the industry.

Taylor moved to California on a tennis scholarship to play at Sonoma State University and graduated with a degree in Biology. During that time, he became interested in the wine industry and took a winery lab tech job that led him to pursue enology and viticulture classes at Napa Valley College. To broaden his experience, he travelled and worked in other wine-growing regions of California, Oregon, and New Zealand. These experiences helped spark his passion for Pinot Noir, cool-climate varietals, geology, and soil science. Upon returning to the U.S., he settled back in Sonoma County, working under several experienced winemakers. As Production Manager at Marimar Estate, Taylor oversees all as-

pects of operations in the cellar and their vineyards. Taylor's focus on efficiency and environmental sustainability.

Marimar Estate focuses on Spanish varietals such as Albariño,
Godello, Tempranillo, Pinot Noir, and Chardonnay. Marimar
Estate Vineyards & Winery, named after proprietor Marimar Torres, is located off Graton Road in the Green Valley area (Russian River Valley AVA). Marimar,

originally from Spain, grew up as a fourth-generation member of the Torres Spanish wine-making family and moved to San Francisco in 1975. She began planting the Don Miguel Vineyard in 1986 and in 1992, and built the winery in the style of a Catalan farmhouse. All wines are produced from estate fruit.
