She has been making fruit wines for many years and has been doing so very successfully. If you have fruit trees or access to them, you might want to give it a try. Most of us have made wine from grapes - why not try other fruit? Be creative, experiment, try something different. According to Vi, fruit wines are not complicated and beginners can obtain good results with basic equipment (fermenter buckets, carboys, corks, and a few other items that you probably already have. She will be going over the basics of how to make fruit wine and will provide be a number of "recipes". Following her talk, she will be pouring 8 wines for tasting; you will need to bring 2 to 4 glasses. Vi Epperson is a semi-retired college instructor, an avid gardener, and loves to experiment in the kitchen.
