You may recall that the event was organized and conducted by GENCO's President Mary Lou Marek, assisted by a many GENCO members. It was an event we can all be proud of.

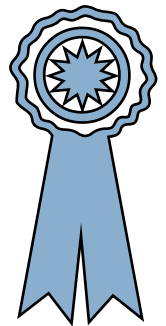
