Adrian began making wine (Pinot Noir) in his garage in 2006 and worked 'crush' for several small wineries for a few years. He studied winemaking and viticulture at UC Davis in their extension program, while studying business management on the side—a smart move. He continued to make wine and focused on making Pinot Noir with a sense of place (Terroir). Ultimately, he and a partner started Joseph Jewell Winery, a play on their names, and opened a tasting room in Forestville. He has an impressive lineup of wines: 5 pinots, 2 Zins, 2 Chardonnays, a Rosé of Pinot Noir, and a couple of interesting outliers: a 'pet nat' sparkling Vermentino, and a skin-contact Pinot Gris for the more adventuresome



and younger crowd. Adrian has graciously offered to bring two of his wines to taste. So, even if you don't make wine, Adrian has an interesting story to tell, some useful insights into winemaking, and some excellent wine to taste – something for everyone.
